Project Overview

The Gorgon Project is a natural gas project involving the development of gas fields located off the northwest coast of Western Australia. The project will see the construction of a 15.6 million tonnes per annum (MTPA) liquefied natural gas (LNG) facility and a domestic gas plant built on Barrow Island, approximately 60 kilometres off the northwest coast of Western Australia.

Chevron Australia awarded CKJV, a joint venture between Chicago Bridge and Iron (CB&I) and Kentz Pty Ltd, the structural, mechanical, piping, electrical, instrumentation and commissioning support contract for the construction of three LNG trains, including associated utilities and a domestic gas processing and compression plant.

ECM has been engaged by the JV to provide craft labour and supervision to facilitate the electrical component of these works.

Scope of Work

- Supply of craft labour, supervision and support for the electrical and instrumentation installation works on the construction of three LNG trains
- Provision of craft labour support for commissioning activities
